Archères Vieilles Vignes **VERMENTINO**, Languedoc-Roussillon, France 12.5% (v) **£23.00**
a light, floral wine, with peach notes and unexpected complexity: if you like Sauvignon, why not give this slightly less dry wine a chance?

Haus **GRÜNER VELTLINER** from Pfaffl, Niederösterreich, Austria 12% (v) **£33.00**
an elegant, crisp wine with apple on the nose and a peppery finish: almost unknown in Britain, this is the pride of Austrian grapes and a real find.

Hermit Crab **VIIGNIER/MARSANNE**, McLaren Vale, Australia 2017 13% **£35.00**
a golden, full-bodied wine, aged in oak and with this grape's distinctive honey and vanilla tones well to the fore.

SOAVE-Bertani Vintage Edition, Cantine Bertani, Soave, Italy 2016 12.5% (v)* **£45.50**
a complex wine with a floral nose giving way to a mouthful of stone-fruit flavours balanced by carefully used acidity: absolutely the value wine on this list.

Mount Pleasant Elizabeth **SEMILLON**, Hunter Valley, Australia 2009 10.5% **£46.00**
a citrus-based beauty of great distinction, huge flavours despite the comparatively low ABV, giving outstanding mouthfeel and a long, fulfilling finish.

Gavi di Gavi, La Minaia, **CORTESE** 2014 13% **£45.00**
white peach and acacia aromatics, with a soft honeyed richness, a cool mineral streak, beautifully balanced and fresh through to a long finish.

Premiér Cru Chablis, Montée de Tonnerre, France **CHARDONNAY** 2015 13% **£55.00**
classically austere and steely Chablis, fruit, chalk and minerals combining to create a well-defined, elegant flavour, leading to a lengthy, peach-infused finish.

Meursault, Domaine Jean-Michel Gaunoux et Fils, Burgundy, **CHARDONNAY** 2015 13% **£65.00**
almost the reverse of the Chablis, with rich tropical fruit and an enticing note of honey giving way to a crisp, clean finish.

Tooma River **SHIRAZ**, New South Wales, Australia 13.5% **£22.00**
rich nose redolent with red and black berry aromas and a smooth, textured palate dripping with juicy dark fruits, hints of chocolate and lively spices.

Les Mougeottes **PINOT NOIR**, Pays D'Oc 13% (v) **£27.00**
a lovely fresh nose of violets and sweet red berries, harmonised by integrated and subtle oak. Rich and velvety on the palate with great poise and structure from the soft tannins.

Umani Ronchi Fonte del Re **LACRIMA DI MORRO D'ALBA**, Marche, Italy 13% (v)* **£40.00**
Italy's almost unknown answer to Gamay, only so much fuller – a complex, yet gentle wine with a long, dry finish. Served lightly chilled 12°C

Perfiles **MALBEC** Trapiche Textura Fina, Argentina 14.5%* **£46.00**
a rich, bursting nose, a lightly smoky flavour and the finest mouthfeel you can imagine: perfection in a bottle.

Secco-Bertani **CORVINA** (blend), Veneto, Italy 13.5% (v)* **£55.00**
an intense ruby wine, with complex notes of fruit, cocoa and pepper mingling in gorgeous fashion, rather like the best Amarone you've never had.

Domaine de la Janesse Chateauneuf-du-Pape **GRENACHE**, Rhône, France 2013 14.5% **£60.00**
a serious wine, fat and lush but with a strong mineral quality and finishing on delicious smooth tannins.

Gevrey Chambertin En Jouse, Domaine Harmond-Geoffroy **PINOT NOIR**,
Burgundy, France 2014 15% (v) **£75.00**
boasting a classic earthy, compost nose, this is a magnificent wine, bursting with juicy fruits, yet soft as silk in the mouth.
